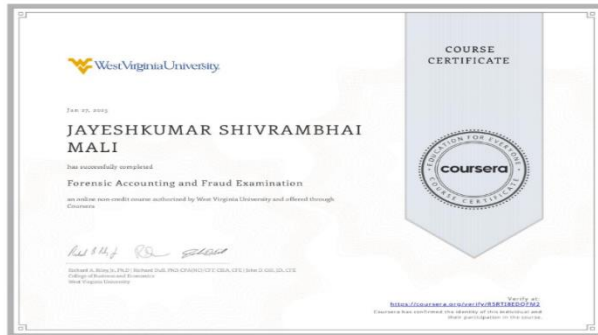
Republic Day
