Poster Making Competition

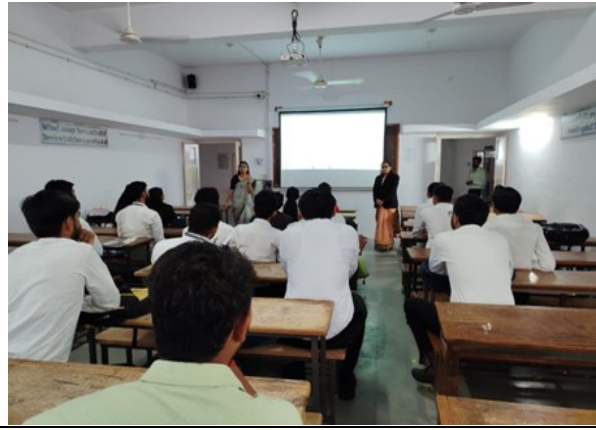

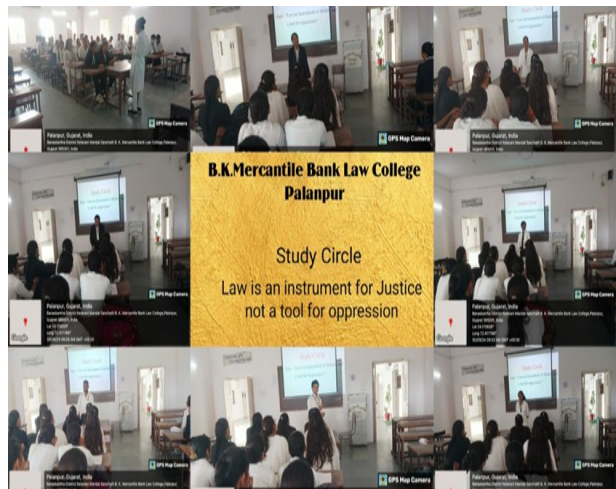
